Library Stars 2014: Best of the Best case studies reflect the conference streams (*Content, Capability and Collaboration*) with the focus on innovation and building stronger, more resilient communities. 38 nominations have been received, with the winners and commended to be presented at the forum. In addition, you will have the opportunity to vote for the Delegates' Choice on the day.

The keynote speaker is Marie Ostergaard, Project Manager, Aarhus Public Libraries, Urban Mediaspace Aarhus – New Central Harbour Square and Mediaspace, City of Aarhus, Denmark. Since 2001 Marie has been part of Aarhus Public Libraries' development of the physical library of the future. Focusing on interactions, user-involvement, network-development, prototyping and communication in the physical library space, Aarhus has investigated new technologies, involvement processes and learning. In a wide range of projects and processes with users, network and partners Marie has focused on the development of the "next library" – the library of the future. For the past 9 years she has worked specifically on implementing and developing these ideas as well as introducing new forms of user- and citizen involvement in the planning and building of Aarhus' new main library – DOKK1 – that opens in 2015.
